Method n°1 : sending files or bibliographic references by e-mail

You can send by e-mail to the database administrators (contacts mentioned above):

- a list of bibliographic references (BibTex, Zotero, Endnote...).
- or the publications PDF files, in compliance with the legal framework.

Method n°2 : contributing to the Zotero group « Science and Ignorance – Contributors » online database library

1. Installing Zotero free software <https://www.zotero.org/>
2. Then, please contact us to let us know the e-mail contact used to create your Zotero account, so that we can add it to the Zotero group. You will then receive an e-mail from Zotero:

science_et_ignorance has invited you to join the group 'Science and Ignorance - Contributors' at Zotero.org You can find more information about this group and accept or decline the invitation »

3. Please click on the confirmation link.

4. After joining the group, click on « Group Library » or on the following link: https://www.zotero.org/groups/1942031/science_and_ignorance_-_contributors/items

This is important: we use this third collection to sort suggestions, interfering with the two first ones would introduce references that are not matched in the catalogue and the archived fund.
